Checklist for Implanting Physician(s)

This checklist is provided as a summary of the information used to process claims for TAVR procedures per the CMS NCD 20.32. This list includes the most commonly used codes and is not all-inclusive. It is the responsibility of the hospital and/or physician to determine appropriate coding for a particular patient and/or procedure. Any claim should be coded appropriately and supported with adequate documentation in the medical record.
